MESA COUNTY FIRE AUTHORITY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 22, 2022

At 7:24 PM Eric Brown called the meeting to order. Chuck Nelson, Eric Brown, Darrell Charlesworth, and Randy Zellner were all in attendance. Wayne DeGesualdo was absent with an excused absence.

Motion to Cancel December's Meeting

Chuck Nelson asked if there was any reason in the budget or in the Chief's report that we might need a December meeting. After a short discussion, Chuck Nelson made a motion to cancel MCFA's December Meeting. Randy Zellner seconded the motion. All were in favor, no opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report

Chuck Nelson presented the treasurers report. Chuck said we are 83% of the way through the year. Ambulance income is a low due to the NPI having the wrong billing address. Chief Cox, Stacy and Chevelle have been working on getting it fixed. Central Orchard Mesa has gone above the 75% required to fund us. Lands End Fire Protection District just put in another \$25,000. Income looks great at 140%. Expenses look great with the expectation of electric services at all three locations. We are at 63% of total budgeted

expenses. Randy Zellner made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Eric Brown seconded the motion. All were in favor, no opposed. Motion Carried.

Chief Cox advised that Whitewater Village Stage 1 is going in with sprinklers. By stage 2, Clifton Water is supposed to be able to support water pressure for hydrates, which we

will have be reevaluated. If they are able to support the hydrates and as they already have changed the road to give us two means of egress, it would be hard to pushing for sprinklers in stage 2 and 3. Each stage will have to have everything analyzed as we go.

Chuck Nelson said he would like to hold both Lands End and Mesa County Fire Authority meetings in January at Station 51. Randy Zellner made a motion to hold January meetings at Station 51. Chuck Nelson seconded it. All were in favor, no opposed. Motion carried.
